#### What is Beta Club?

The National Beta Club Mission Statement: To promote the ideals of academic achievement, character, service and leadership among elementary and secondary school students.

Achievement: Recognizing and honoring high academic achievement

Character: Preparing young people for life and empowering them to be successful

Leadership: Developing the leaders of tomorrow

Service: Demonstrating our motto: Let Us Lead by Serving Others

## How can I get into Beta Club?

Model a character of integrity, leadership, service and academic achievement

- Complete a membership application form & submit a transcript (accredited or unaccredited)
- Receive approval from the Beta Club sponsor and EN Eluminatus Director
- Establish and maintain a 3.5 cumulative GPA and have no significant disciplinary issues
- Be a ninth through twelfth grade student at Eluminatus or receive EN transcription services
  - Ninth grade students may apply mid-year (in January) after one semester showing 3.5 GPA in High School. They do not apply first semester.

## What does it cost to join Beta Club?

- The first year you join, Beta Club will cost \$52. \$32 is sent to the National Organization for your new member registration and \$20 remains with the chapter for certificates and other items.
- Annual dues years 2 and following are currently set at \$20

#### What must I do if I am in Beta Club?

- Continue to model a character of integrity, leadership, service, and academic achievement
- Maintain a 3.5 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Complete one Beta Club or Eagle's Nest sponsored service project per semester (2 hours minimum)
- Submit service hours showing a minimum of 10 hours of community service per semester (submit Dec & May)
- Be actively present for at least 2 of the Beta Club meetings to be held during the academic year OR attend 2 additional Beta / EN service projects beyond the two required for membership

## How can I get dismissed from Beta Club?

- Do not complete the required hours of service of 10 per semester & 1 EN sponsored event per semester
- Do not maintain a 3.5 GPA
  - Grades will be checked at the end of each year in July. A student will be placed on probation for 1 semester in order to regain the 3.5 GPA. If student is unable to re-establish the grade point average, the student will be dismissed from Beta Club.
- Do not exemplify behavior which supports the Beta Club Mission statement

## **Key Points for Applicants:**

- 1. You and your parents must sign the application form after you have filled out the information.
- Completed applications are due back to Mrs. Craycraft no later than <u>Thursday</u>, <u>August 31th</u> by 4:00pm. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS FOR LATE APPLICATIONS! You may deliver the application and fee to Mrs. Craycraft either by placing in her <u>Tutor Folder at Eluminatus</u>, or by mail to: <u>Carrie Craycraft</u>, 187 <u>Timber Mill</u>, <u>Newnan</u>, <u>GA 30263</u>. \*\*\*NOTE: A fee of \$52.00 will need to be paid. <u>Make check payable to Eagle's Nest</u>.
- Once your application and the required unofficial transcript (accredited or unaccredited) is submitted for review, you will be notified of acceptance. If you are not accepted for any reason, your application fee will be returned to you.
